"Some of us can remember when in the village church the gallery was occupied by the village band, fiddles and viol, ophocleide*, flute, etc.
. . . no doubt the playing was not very good, and the instruments were out of tune — no doubt also there was much quarrelling and little harmony among the performers .." Old Country Life.

So wrote Reverend Sabine Baring-Gould in 1890. He believed the institution should have been improved, not abolished.
